

# Musical Memory Game

In this addition of Hamoadon, our theme is Immigration Stories. We have included a focus on the Yemenite- Israeli singer Ofra Haza. Inspired by Haza's story, we have included a popular Israeli game.

**Game length: 5-20 Minutes**

**Number of players: 7 players or more**

One volunteer will go away from the group. The rest of the students will then divide into pairs. Each pair must think of a line from a song and split that line in half – one person will get the first half and one will get the second.

Alternatively, we have included a set of cards with split song lyrics for you to share out.

The pairs will then separate, and the group will stand in a circle with the volunteer standing in the middle. His goal is to find the song pairs. The volunteer will point at someone in the circle and that student will sing their half of the song. When the volunteer finds a pair (completing the song sentence) those students sit down.
